The schedule of the event may possibly be changed depending to the number of the participants and after consultation with the organizing committee.

Categories of Competition

J-A: Juniors: Kids Mixed Category (8-12 years old)

J-B: Juniors: Kids Mixed Category (13-15 years old)

J-C: Juniors: Teenagers Mixed Category (16-17 years old)

M-K: Men Kyu (4 kyu & above)

M-D: Men Dan

M-V: Men Veterans (45 years old and above & at least 2nd dan)

W-K: Women Kyu (4 kyu & above)

W-D: Women Dan

W-V: Women Veterans (45 years old and above & at least 2nd dan)

T: Team Category

KA: Kata

Notes:

There is no limit of the participants' number at individual competition.

In case a category doesn't contain enough competitors, it will be merged into another one.

6th -5th kyu holders, who would like to participate to the tournament, have to ask for permission of their sensei, who has the responsibility of them, and they have to know about the implementing regulations during the shiai.

J-A: Juniors: Kids Mixed Category

In Kids Mixed Category only kids between 8 and 12 years old are allowed to participate.

J-B: Juniors: Kids Mixed Category

In Teenagers Mixed Category only teenagers between 13 and 15 years old are allowed to participate.

J-C: Juniors: Teenagers Mixed Category

In Teenagers Mixed Category only teenagers between 16 and 17 years old are allowed to participate. They are also allowed to take part at the adults categories tournament with the written consent of their parents or guardians.

M-K, M-D:

Men are competing according to their level in Kyu or Dan Category. In case of insufficient participation the two categories will be merged.

W-K, W-D:

Women are competing according to their level in Kyu or Dan category. In case of insufficient participation the two categories will be merged.

M-V & W-V: Veterans Category:

Competitors must be over 45 years old and hold at least the 2nd dan in Kendo.

Four is the minimum number of participants in order to create this category.

If the number of four participants is not achieved, they will be included into the Men's or Women's Individual Categories or form a mixed men and women veteran category.

If the number of participants is enough, it is possible that subcategories are created.

T: Team Category

Every club can participate with two teams of five plus two competitors in each team. If they have an extra team, it has to be named after a neutral name ex. Musashi.

It is possible that mixed teams will be created with spare competitors who don't form any team of their own club. In such case the organizing committee has the liability to form the mixed groups. Such individual participants must not forget to mention their availability into a mixed team at their registration form.

K: Kata : Kata requirements

6th-4th Kyu : Bokuto Ni Yoru Kendo Kihon-waza: 1-9

3rd-1st Kyu: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5

1st Dan : Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5

2nd Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-7

3rd Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-7

4th Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-10

5th Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-10

Participants will compete in pairs which will be decided by drawing. They have to be of the same grade of the category that they compete. It is their responsibility to form pairs and to declare it to their registration form. If not, the organising committee will match the spare participants.

In each category 3 pairs are needed to register, if not then they will compete with the next category. Kata selection will be announced just before the Taikai. Participants are going to compete in 3 kata, except of the final where they have to show 5 kata.

Note: Every club has to carry its own **tasuki**.

Individual & Team Competition

All the matches will be conducted into two phases:

A. Pools of 3 or 4 fighters/teams (2 of them qualified) with duration of 3 min.

B. Knock out system with duration of 3 min. Semifinals will have duration of 4 min and finals 5 min.

Attention: Each club is represented by one leader, who is the only person that is allowed to get closer to the secretary or to the score boards. Any noncompliance maybe result to the disqualification of the fighter or the team.

Pool system will be conducted according to the rules of EKF for the EKC 2019 .

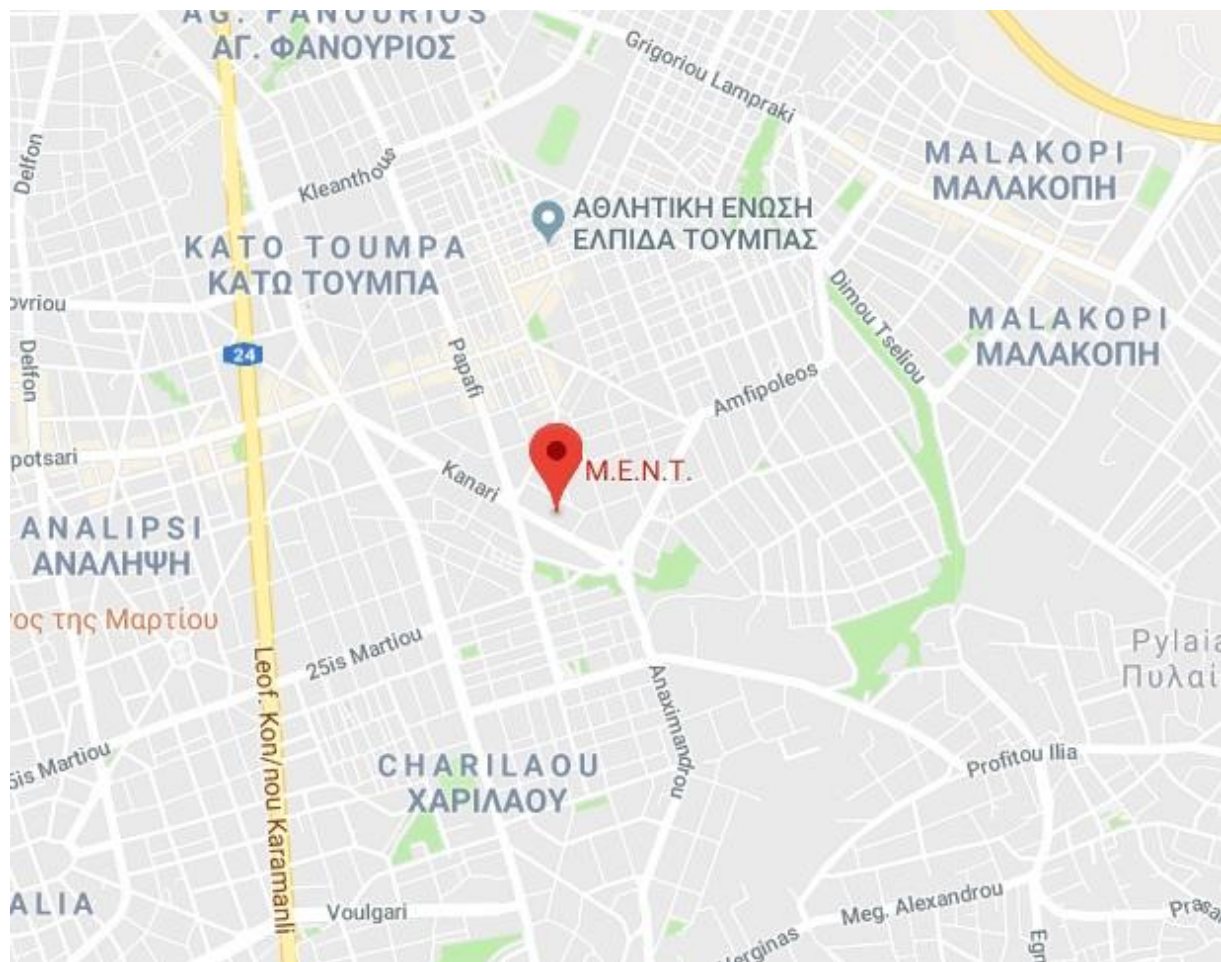
