Categories of Competition

J-K: Kids & Junior Kihon waza: kirikaeshi & uchikomi

J-B: Kids & Junior bougu (7-12, 13-15, 16-17 years old)

M-K: Men Kyu (4 kyu & above)

M-D: Men Dan

M-V: Men Veterans (45 years old & above)

W-K: Women Kyu (4 kyu & above)

W-D: Women Dan

W-V: Women Veterans (45 years old & above)

K: Kata

<u>Notes:</u> There is no limit in the number of participants in individual competition. In case that a category doesn't contain enough competitors it will be merged into the next one.

For 6^{th} -5th kyu holders that would like to participate to the tournament, they have to ask the permission of their club which has the responsibility of them that they know the proper manners of the shiai.

J-K: Kids & Junior Kihon waza: kirikaeshi & uchikomi

J-B: Kids & Junior bougu

The participants will be split into categories according to their age (7-12, 13-15, 16-17 years old) at the time of the actual championship day. no junior is allowed to compete with adults.

T: Team

Every club can participate with two teams of five plus two competitors.

It is possible mixed teams to be created with spare competitors who don't form any team of their club. In such case the organizing committee has the liability to form the mixed groups. Such individual participants not to forget to mention their availability into a mixed team during their registration form.

<u>Attention:</u> Each club is represented by one leader who is the only person that is allowed to get closer to the secretary, or to the score boards. In any noncompliance maybe result to the Disqualification of the fighter or the team.

M-V & W-V: Veterans.

Conditions: 45 years old and 2nd dan in Kendo.

Four participants is the minimum in order to create this category although men's and women's division could join into a mixed category. If the number of four participants is not achieved then they will be included into the men's or women's category. It is also possible to create subcategories of every 5 years age but it depends of the nr of participants and it lies on the liability of the organizing committee.

K: Kata

Kata requirements

6th-4th Kyu: Kihon kata 1-9

3rd-1st Kyu: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5 1st Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5 2nd-3rd Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-7 4th-5th Dan: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-10

Participants will compete in pairs which will be decided by drawing. they have to be of the same grade of the category that they compete. In each category 4 pairs are needed to register, if not then they will compete with the next category. Kata will be announced just before the Taikai. Participants are going to compete in 3 katas except the final where they have to show 5 katas.

Individual & Team Competition

All the matches will be conducted into two phases:

A. Pools of 3 or 4 fighters/teams (2 of them qualified) with duration of 3 min.

B. Knock out system with duration of 3 min, semifinals and finals duration of 5 min.

in the pool system will be conducted according to the rules of EKF for the EKC 2017.

SEMINAR

participants will attend the seminar in separated groups according to their level and pole and will be assisted by the high rank teachers.

It is possible to have also kids group during the seminar so their parents may contact us to discuss that option.

KENDO EXAMINATION /SHINSA 1-4 Dan

- 1. In the context of 11th Thessaloniki Kendo Cup 2017, (17-19/3/2017), HKINF will conduct a Kendo examination 1-4 Dan Kendo, on Saturday 18 March 2017, noon time, in Kolindros Sport Center, Kolindros, Pieria (Northern Greece). HKINF Secretariat will organize the examination.
- 2. Examination committees will be composed by invited teachers and HKINF senior members.
- 3. For a smooth conduct of the grading the following instructions are provided:
- a. Candidates should have the minimum required time between examination: 6 months, 1 year, 2 years, 3 years from Ikkyu, 1 Dan, 2 Dan and 3 Dan respectively.
- b. **Application Forms should be received** by HKINF Deputy Secretary Christos Anagnostopoulos, e-mail eokin.depsec@gmail.com by Friday 3 March 2017. Following that date no application will be accepted. For non HKINF members a written authorization from their respective Federation President is MANDATORY.
- c. Candidates should, on Saturday 18 March 2017, provide Grading Secretariat (at the vent's venue) written President's Authorization (non HKINF members), EKF Yellow Card for Shodan and higher and pay the relevant examination fee (1 dan 20 €, 2 dan 25€, 3 dan 30€, 4 dan 40€).
- d. Immediately following the examination, successful candidates should pay the relevant Registration Fee (Ikkyu & 1 dan 10 €, 2 dan 15€, 3 dan 20€, 4 dan, 50€). Failure to do so may cancel any successful results.
- e. <u>A minimum number of three candidates for Yondan grading is required</u>, for the proper conduct of the examination. In case of less number of candidates the relevant examination will not take place.
- f. Participation at the seminar is mandatory for any grading candidates. Registration and payment of seminar fees should be done through the event organizers.
