• **CATEGORIES OF COMPETITION**

J-K: Kids & Juniors Kihon waza : kirikaeshi & uchikomi

J-B: Kids & Junior bougu

KH-A: Adults Kihon waza : kirikeashi & uchikomi

M-K: Men Kyu (4 kyu & above)

M-D: Men Dan

M-V: Men Veterans (45 years old & above)

W-K: Women Kyu (4 kyu & above)

W-D: Women Dan

W-V: Women Veterans (45 years old & above)

K: Kata

Notes:

There is no limit of the participants' number at individual competition.

In case a category doesn't contain enough competitors, it will be merged into another one(ex. Juniors category will be merged with Adults Category according to the participants' sex and grade, Women kyu/Men kyu category with Women Dan/Men Dan category etc). 6th -5th kyu holders, who would like to participate to the tournament, have to ask for permission of their sensei, who has the responsibility of them, and they have to know about the implementing regulations during the shiai.

J-K: Kids & Juniors Kihon waza : kirikaeshi & uchikomi

J-B: Kids & Junior bougu

The participants will be split into categories (7-12, 13-15, 16-17 years old) according to the age they will have at the time of the actual championship day.

KH-A: Adult Kihon Waza : kirikaeshi & uchikomi

Beginners or holders of 6th or 5th kyu, who are not capable of competing with bougu, have the opportunity to compete at kihon waza (kirikaeshi, uchikomi).

M-K, M-D:

Men are competing according to their level in Kyu or Dan category. In case of insufficient participation the two categories will be merged.

W-K, W-D:

Women are competing according to their level in Kyu or Dan category. In case of insufficient participation the two categories will be merged.

T : Team Category

Every club can participate with two teams of five plus two competitors in each team. If they have an extra team, it has to be named after a neutral name ex. Musashi.

It is possible that mixed teams will be created with spare competitors who don't form any team of their own club. In such case the organizing committee has the liability to form the mixed groups. Such individual participants must not forget to mention their availability into a mixed team at their registration form.

M-V & W-V: Veterans.

Conditions : Competitors must be over 45 years old and hold at least the 2nd dan in Kendo.

Three is the minimum number of participants in order to create this category.

If the number of three participants is not achieved, they will be included into the men's or women's individual categories or form a mixed men and women veteran category.

If the number of participants is big enough, it is possible that subcategories are created (ex.45-50 50-55 etc).

All the above lie on the liability of the organizing committee.

K: Kata : Kata requirements

6th-4th Kyu : Bokuto Ni Yoru Kendo Kihon-waza: 1-9

3rd-1st Kyu: Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5

1st Dan : Nihon Kendo Kata 1-5

2nd-3rd Dan : Nihon Kendo Kata 1-7

4th-5th Dan : Nihon Kendo Kata 1-10

Participants will compete in pairs. It is their responsibility to form pairs as they could prepare themselves for the competition into their club or during the seminar.

If a participant is coming to the Kata competition without a partner he has to apply it during his registration so the organizing committee will try to create a pair with another individual competitor.

Competitors have to be of the same grade of the category that they compete. In each category 3 pairs are needed to register, if not then they will compete with the next category. Kata selection will be announced just before the Taikai. Participants are going to compete in 3 kata, except of the final where they have to show 5 kata.

Note: Every club has to carry its own tasuki as they will not be provided by the organizer

Duration of Individual & Team Competition

All the matches will be conducted into two phases:

A. Pools of 3 or 4 fighters/teams (2 of them qualified) with duration of 3 min.

B. Knock out system with duration of 3 min and finals duration of 5 min.

Attention: Each club is represented by one leader who is the only person that is allowed to get closer to the secretary or to the score boards. Any noncompliance may have as a result to the Disqualification of the fighter or the team.

Pool system will be conducted according to the rules of EKF for the EKC 2017 .

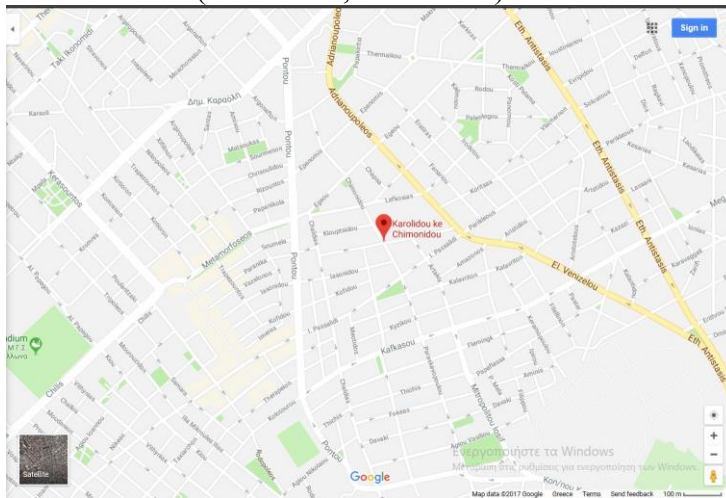

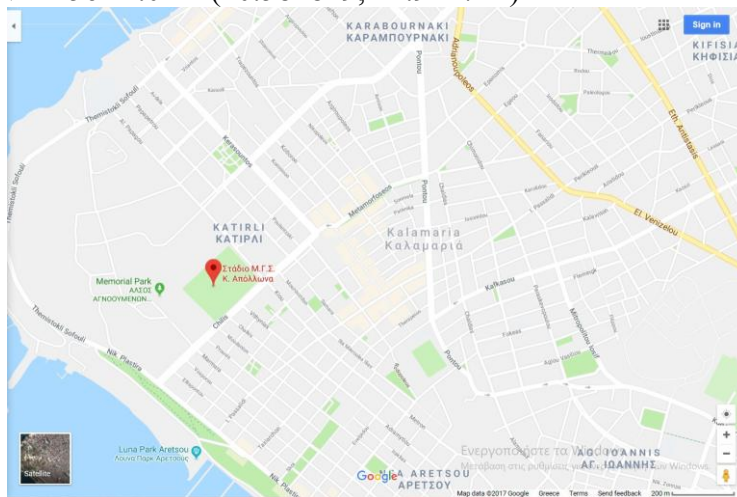


Venue of Friday evening keiko 16/03/2018
